Day One: Monday, Jan 31, 2022

Depart Pittsburgh or Newark, NJ for Israel. Meals and overnight: In flight.

Day Two: Tuesday, Feb 1, 2022

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport in Israel. Transfer to the hotel near the Mediterranean coast for dinner and a good night's rest! Dinner and overnight: Tel Aviv area. D

Day Three: Wednesday, Feb 2, 2022

Four Conflicts in the Background of the Gospels: Highlighting example sites, this study focuses on four key conflicts in the background of Jesus' public ministry. Sites: Caesarea Maritima, Mt. Carmel, Valley of Armageddon, Zippori, Nazareth (including cave homes). Overnight: Sea of Galilee area. B, D

Day Four: Thursday, Feb 3, 2022

<u>Characteristics of the Disciples</u>: Using the four gospel accounts, we will investigate the hints on the background, education and theology of the disciples. Sites: Mt. Arbel, Magdala, Mt. Beatitudes, Capernaum, Ancient Boat exhibit, boat ride. Overnight: By the Sea of Galilee. B, D

Day Five: Friday, Feb 4, 2022

<u>Private Teachings for the Disciples</u>: Based on the five sermons in the Gospel according to Matthew, our focus will be on the common teaching style of the ancient rabbis. Sites: Tel Dan, Banias (Caesarea Philippi), overlook into Syria, Qatzrin (Talmudic Village). Overnight: By the Sea of Galilee. B, D

Day Six: Saturday, Feb 5, 2022

<u>The Perean Ministry of Jesus</u>: We will address the issues of the Perean Ministry, with particular examination of Luke 10-19, the "special section" of this account. Sites: Beth Shean, Jordan Valley, Jericho overlook, Qumran, Dead Sea. Overnight: Dead Sea spa hotel. B, D

Day Seven: Sunday, Feb 6, 2022

<u>Hebrew Themes of the Wilderness</u>: From the desert storm of Habakkuk, to the salt covenant of David, various Biblical wilderness themes will be highlighted, and then "Up to Jerusalem". Sites: Masada, En Gedi. Overnight: Jerusalem. B,D

Day Eight: Monday, Feb 7, 2022

<u>Messianic Expectations and Disappointments</u>: With a specific view of the history of "other Messiahs" we will discuss the expectations for the Messiah, and their relationship to the record of the preaching of Jesus.

<u>Setting of the Birth Narrative</u>: We will investigate what the Biblical accounts tell us of Jesus' birth, based on both the Matthew and Luke accounts.

Sites: Mt. of Olives, Gethsemane, Bethlehem, Shepherd's Fields area. Overnight: Jerusalem. B,D

Day Nine: Tuesday, Feb 8, 2022

<u>A Living People:</u> Visit to Yad Vashem (Holocaust Memorial) or Gush Etzion. Jewish Quarter (Cardo, Broad Wall, Herodian mansions), Western Wall plaza, Davidson Center with the Southern steps. Overnight: Jerusalem. B, D

Day Ten: Wednesday, Feb 9, 2022

<u>Jewish Questionings and Roman Trials of Jesus</u>: The arrest, trial and conviction of Jesus will be our subject as we journey through the "salvation geography" of Jerusalem in the Gospel according to John. Sites: Temple Mount, Pools of Bethesda, Via Dolorosa, Holy Sepulchre, Garden Tomb (with communion). Overnight: Jerusalem. B, D

Day Eleven: Thursday, Feb 10, 2022

Day at leisure. You'll have time to shop, do additional sightseeing, or just relax and take in the local culture. B,D

Day Twelve: Friday, Feb 11, 2022

Return flight from Tel Aviv to Newark (EWR), with connections to Pittsburgh, arriving later the same day.
