



One of our goals at Gateway is to move people from “**Rows to Circles.**” It can be impossible to truly connect on a Sunday morning in a room full of people. However, we desire all of our people to be connected to **a Group that meets on a regular basis and provides a space for each person to Experience Community. Each Group is committed to Encountering Jesus in the truth of Scripture, Engaging in prayer together, and helping each other to Embrace the Mission that each of us has been called to pursue.**

This **Groups Guide** is for all Groups to utilize even if yours is studying something other than the Sunday Conversation. Additional resources are provided weekly to allow for Groups to connect through **prayer, worship, discipleship, service, and fellowship.** Leaders are encouraged to implement these elements in any order and to feel free to make substitutions or additions.

PRAYER: Continuing the conversation God already started

- Group Leader or group member can open in prayer &/or group members can share praises or how they need prayer and then group members can pray together
- If leading prayer is an area of uncertainty, read a verse/passage (such as Psalm 119:11; 133. James 1:22) and play some background music for a couple minutes while praying silently and meditating on the verses read (instrumental worship: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mRLs5xTrneQ>).

WORSHIP: With all we are and all we've been given

- **Diving In** to this Week's Conversation: *Asking open ended questions or phrases that prompt group members to go deeper is encouraged* - "How do you see _____ showing up in your life?" "Tell us more about that." "Keep going with that." "What does that show us about Jesus?" etc.
 - What stood out to you from the weekend conversation? Anything confuse you? Convict you? Encourage you?
 - Reflecting on how Pastor Scott began this series [April 11th] discuss why he said "KNOWING JESUS INTIMATELY" must be the foundation to build all the other MARKS OF A DISCIPLE on.
 - Pastor Jon shared this quote from Larry Crabb: "If The Gospel isn't the answer to your problem, then you don't understand your problem." How does this influence our understanding of what a disciple of Jesus is called to be?
 - This WKND's "Mark" of a disciple is connected with part of the GTWY Code. Talk about how this conviction is/is not held by YOU & YOUR FAMILY CIRCLE, and the people in your circles of life. "We recognize the Bible as God's absolute authority on our lives.
 - Select one of the examples shared Sunday: [1 Samuel 15-King Saul] or Matthew 9-Dinner Party] and explore how God's heart for obedience is revealed through the stories.
 - Review the following Scriptures together [Great Memory Verses for your family!] and discuss practical ways to develop a lifestyle of OBEDIENCE to GOD. Psalm 119:11; 133. James 1:22
 - Pray through the Thread To Pull together: "If I was arrested for my belief in Jesus Christ, would there be enough evidence that I listened to His voice, Obeyed His Word, and Modeled His Heart on a daily basis?"
